All: Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.

One: Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion!

All: Shout, daughter of Jerusalem!

One: See, your king comes to you, righteous and having salvation,
gentle and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.

**All: A very large crowd spread their cloaks on the road, while others
cut branches from the trees and spread them on the road.**
