

To create your own card, print out or copy the Bingo template on the next page. Enter a number in each square of the Bingo card according to the guidelines below. The numbers can be ascending, descending, or mixed—the order within each column doesn't matter.

B column: choose from numbers 1-15

I column: choose from numbers 16-30

N column: choose from numbers 31-45

G column: choose from numbers 46-60

O column: choose from numbers 61-75

You can color your Bingo card however you'd like. You'll also need something to cover each individual square when it's called. Pepperidge Farm Goldfish, pretzels, and M&M's work especially well for this because you can eat them after every game! Or, you can use dried beans, small rocks, shells, whatever (but don't eat those ☺). That way, you can re-use your Bingo card over and over again.
